SUBJECT: Better Opportunities for Single Soldiers (BOSS) Run Club

1. This is to certify that <u>SPC XXX XXXX</u> has volunteered for the Better Opportunities for Single Soldiers (BOSS) Run Club. The Fort Stewart/Hunter Army Airfield BOSS Team has accepted their participation in all Run Club events.

2. The Soldier is currently IAW FM 7-22 and AR 600-9 and is able to actively participate and meet the United States Army Standard.

3. The Fort Stewart BOSS team has a physical fitness program for individuals that are qualified and have volunteered to participate. The BOSS Run Club is voluntary. Soldiers are not obligated to participate. This physical fitness program is designed to improve the Soldiers morale and bring a sense of esprit décor for their BOSS team.

4. The Soldiers that choose to attend the BOSS Run Club are required to be at PT formation each day and are required to stay during the entire PT session. If a soldier fails to report to PT without a valid excuse, his First Sergeant will be contacted. Soldiers who fail to comply with the BOSS Run Club PT rules will be dropped from the team.

5. The BOSS Run Club will be at 0630 – UTC, every Wednesday at the Fort Stewart, GA Quick Track. There may be some variation in training location based on daily training goals.

6. Accountability of all participating individuals will be reported to the Company First Sergeant NLT 0645 to ensure an accurate PERSTAT. The PT program will not exceed 0900 work call.

7. Soldiers must obtain their command's approval to attend the BOSS Run Club. The Soldier's command endorsement verifies the candidate is currently not on profile and is deemed fit for additional physical training. At this time, the Soldier **may** / **may not** attend the BOSS Run Club.
